

THE FOUR STEPS OF EAS



1 | INTAKE AND ASSESSMENT



Initial interviews with organizational staff to evaluate current state



Document assessment – Investment policy, constating documents including by-laws, other relevant policies (planned giving, privacy, conflict of interest)



Investment assessment – initial review of investment managers, governance structures and decision-making processes



2 I FORMAL REVIEW



Policy Review – We will suggest amendments to relevant policies to reflect the organization's future state requirements



Governance Review – We will suggest changes to streamline and improve decisionmaking processes around investment oversight



Investment Requirements – We work with the Board, Investment Committee (IC) and Staff to finalize investment requirements



3 | INTAKE OF INVESTMENT MANAGERS



We will identify Investment providers who are well-suited for the organization's needs



If necessary, we will help prepare a "Request for Proposals" to invite appropriate managers to submit proposals



We support the Board, IC and Staff through the decision-making process



4 I ONGOING SUPPORT



We support the ongoing review of investment policies and structures



We provide advisory support around planned and complex gifts



We host an annual meeting to re-assess investment requirements
